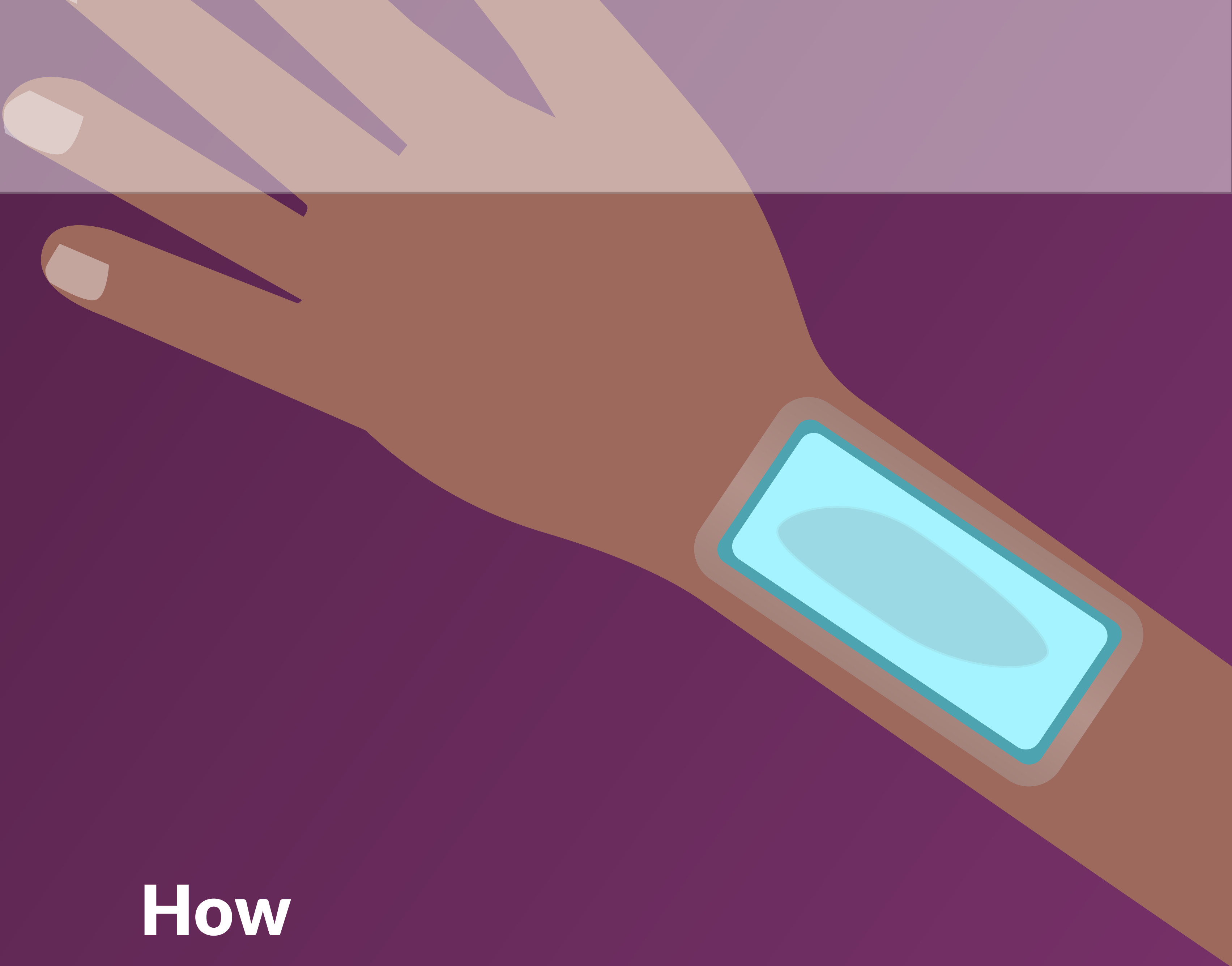




Basic Wound Care
